

Patrick May's Eagle Project



For my Eagle project we will be needing volunteers for 2 weekends in November. Sunday November 8th and the weekend of November 14th. *The second date will require an overnight stay in Southwestern Wisconsin.**

Part I: Sign Construction

The Eagle Project will consist of constructing a sign on Sunday November 8th, from 9:00 AM until 4:00 PM.

There will be 2 shifts:

The first shift will be from 10 AM until Noon.

Second shift will be from 1:00 PM until 4:00 PM.

Lunch will be provided at Noon and if you are working the second shift, you are welcome to come early and eat. **We need to have a minimum of 4 scouts and 1 adult sign up for each session.** You are welcome to work both if you like.

The sign portion of the project will be constructed at Joe Madson's house. His address is 2034 Coach Dr., Naperville, IL

Instructions to his house are: South on Naper Blvd. West on 87th Street (right) and North (right) on Coach. His house is on the corner of Coach and Warwick Ave.

What will be needed for this project is:

- Gloves and safety glasses
- Wear work pants
- Boots/tennis shoes and old sweatshirt

There will be sanding, painting and staining involved with the project and your clothes may get dirty.

Part II: Sign Installation and Landscaping, Weekend of November 14th

The second part of my project will be an overnight campout stay at my Grandfather's farm in Southwestern Wisconsin. We will be leaving on Saturday November 14th at 6:00 AM and returning home on Sunday in the afternoon.

The project involves removal of existing sign and stripping and sanding of the existing sign poles and installing the new sign, while another crew is removing existing grass/weeds and installing landscape and limestone rock inside the cemetery in 2 corners of the cemetery.

The project requires a minimum of 10 Scouts and 6 Adults in order to complete the project in the allotted weekend timeframe. Because there will be 3 meals and travel involved; the cost for the weekend is \$15.00 per person in order to cover the cost of the food and travel.

What is needed for this installation and campout is:

- Personal Gear for camping overnight.
- Work gloves, boots, and work clothes
- Personal water bottle/nalgene

We also need tools if you have them:

- Rakes
- Shovels
- Safety goggles for the sanding of the sign poles.

We will be hauling the troop trailer up to Wisconsin so we will have all of the camping gear that is typically provided for a campout along with the food and drink.

We will provide lunch, dinner on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday morning.

I recommend bringing a snack for the trip up to Wisconsin. It is about a 3 hour trip. My Grandfather's farm address is 1824 Fairplay Rd., Cuba City WI, 53807. His number is 608-748-4378.
