TRANSPORTATION

Since Big Timber is within council boundaries and this is a District event so transportation is on an individual basis. We will be trying to set up carpools to save gas and make as much room as is possible for boys whose parents can't drive them up to Elgin.

FRIDAY:

Friday night camping is optional. We will try to arrange carpooling once we have all of the boys registrations at the Troop meeting on the 23rd. Carpools will be announced at the Troop meeting on the 30th. If you wish you may drive directly to Big Timber on your own, but you must let us know if you are going to do that. Outdoor tent camping can be arranged if we have two adults and two boys that want to do so. Otherwise camping will be in one of the lodges, but be prepared for cold weather sleeping as the lodges are NOT all centrally heated. Adults and boys will have separate lodges.

SATURDAY:

Be at Big Timber K Lodge by 8:30AM. More information about our town location will be available later this month if you will be arriving late so you will know where to go. Set up of the Town events will take place until 10AM when the events start. Lunch will be served at K Lodge. Hot chocolate will be available in our town and at warming centers.
